

2006 The 22nd Taiwanese & Chinese American Athletic Tournament
Swimming Rules

1. Place: Fremont High School, Sunnyvale
1279 Sunnyvale-Saratoga Road Sunnyvale, CA 94087
2. Date :
Swimming competitions will be held as scheduled on 07/23/2006 (Sunday) and starting at 12:15 PM. Swimmer who passes the due time will be treated as "Give up". Pool opens for swimmer to warm up from 12:00 PM.
3. Competition will be held as scheduled event with none stopping accordingly. Please check your own schedule events and get prepared. Current contest event No. will be displayed next to the starting referee during competition,
4. Swimmer must check in 15 minutes before event starts and wait behind the assigned swimming lane.
5. When the competition begins, if swimmer is not shown beside the swimming lane or misses the due time and will be treated as "Give up" for that particular event.
6. If any particular event has fewer swimmers, then it will be combined with other event and record the results separately. Please review the schedule.
7. Length of swimming lane is 25 yards, round trip 50 yards ◦
8. IM sequence will be butterfly, back stroke, breast stroke and free style accordingly.
9. IM relay sequence will be butterfly, back stroke, breast stroke and free style accordingly
10. The swimming event can not be replaced or changed after registered or added on competition site
11. The first, second and third place of each event will be awarded medal.
12. If any disputation happens, it will be judged by chief referees and can not be contested.
13. Each swimming team needs to assign some volunteers to do check-in, timing, broadcasting, time record receiving, data input, event scheduling, results publishing and prize-giving based on percentage of the total swimming registered.
14. Each lane has three referees, two for time recording and one for check and record.
15. Visitors and non checking in swimmers should not crowd at starting place.
16. Please do not play loud music during competition,
17. Please bring any ID that can prove the swimmer age, in case the board or other swimmers might ask to check it.
18. After one hour of competition, if you are in the top three places, you can get the reward from prize-giving group.
19. Each swimmer must match the age group and event; however swimmer can attend higher level events if interested. If relay has fewer swimmers attend, team can be combined with different age group. However, the event must be closed to the F-6, M-6, F-7 or M-7 according to the swimmers' age. Female swimmer can replace male swimmer, but male swimmer can not replace female swimmer.
