SHOOTING MATCHES

[A] **Purpose:** Chinese sportsmen have long been preeminent in competitive shooting. The main objectives of holding the shooting matches in 2007 Taiwanese and Chinese American Athletic Tournament of San Francisco Bay Area are to promote competitive shooting within Chinese Americans as a valuable form of sport, dedicate firearm safety education, facilitate the enjoyable competition experience between shooters, and introduce the sportsmanship of shooting activity to our society.

[B] **Eligibility of Competitors:** Chinese American or Chinese age twelve (12) years or above, has minimum two times public range shooting experiences, and is eligible to possess firearms and ammunition under U.S. Federal and California laws. Any competitor under age eighteen (18) years can only enter the “Junior Rifle” match registered by his/her legal guardian, and must be supervised by his/her legal guardian at the shooting range at all time. Shooters who won the first place in any of the individual match (excluding team match) within the past two (2) years are suggested to participate the same match as a Distinguished Shooter shooting his/her Distinguished Match.

[C] **Discipline, Matches, and Equipments:** Shooters are responsible for their eye and ear protection, and provide own California legal firearms and ammunition for their match. The matches include: Men Pistol, Women Pistol, Open Team Pistol, Open Trap, Open Rifle, Open Junior Rifle. Open matches are open to men and women. A Distinguished Shooter is not competing his/her score in that match. Each team consists of 5 shooters and the team score is the aggregate of the 5 shooters. All firearms must be centerfired (except in “Junior Rifle” match) and equipped with iron open sights only. The shooting position is off-hand standing (except in “Junior Rifle” match):

(1) Pistol: Use centerfire pistol, 25 caliber or above firing minimum 30 shots. 22 caliber rimfire or above can be used in women pistol. The firing course includes 3 strings, each slow fire (5 shots in 2.5min.) and timed fire (5 shots in 20sec.). The target is National Rifle Association B8 target (25 yard timed/rapid fire pistol target) and fired at 25 yards.

(2) Trap: Use 12-gauge shotgun for single trap shooting firing minimum 50 shots. No shells over 3 drams, 7 1/2 shot.

(3) Rifle: Use centerfire highpower rifle, 223 caliber or above firing minimum 20 shots. The firing course is slow fire (10 shots in 10min.). The target is National Rifle Association SR-1 target (200 yard short range rifle target) scaled down to 50 yards and fired at 50 yards.

(4) Junior Rifle: Use only rimfire rifles in .22 Long Rifle (.22 LR) caliber firing minimum 20 shots. The firing course is 20 shots in 10min., and the shooting position can be bench rest. The target is National Rifle Association A-7/5 target (75 foot small bore rifle target) and fired at 75 feet.

[D] **Match Schedule:** The match date/time is July 01, 2007 (Sun.) 9am. The match location is at Los Altos Rod and Gun Club (Address: 14750 Skyline Boulevard, Los Gatos CA 95033; Tel: 408-867-3106; <http://www.losaltosrodandgunclub.com/>).

[E] **Registration:** The match fee is \$25/person for one match; \$40/person for two matches; \$50/person for three matches (no additional charge for team match). The Distinguished Match fee of a Distinguished Shooter is waived. The deadline for registration is June 25, 2007. Please send registration form and fee to “Chinese Culture Center/TCAAT” (Address: 1269 Forgewood, Sunnyvale CA 94089; Tel: 408-747-0394). The fee can be paid by money order, cashier check or personal check payable to “TCAAT”.

*** ATTENTION ***

1. The range rule and range officer must be obeyed promptly. Refusal will result in immediate expulsion from the match and range. Anyone under the age of 12 years will not be allowed to enter the range. The legal guardian of the junior competitor (in the age of 18-12 years) will be required to sign a Participation Form on the match date to be solely responsible for the acts and safety of his/her junior competitor.
2. A firearm safety seminar is temporarily scheduled at Chinese Culture Center on June 24 (Sun), 2007, 10am. The seminar will invite experienced competitors to explain the detail of shooting discipline and firearm safety issue; to share the information of current firearm regulation, hunting activity, and competition experience with you. This seminar is free and welcome to all general public (Junior Rifle competitors must participate).
3. Shooter can register as non-competing shooter in any event to shoot in the same firing course with other competitors. In that case, the target will be kept by the non-competing shooter himself/herself without further scoring.
4. Each shooter must file one registration form, including each shooter in the team match.
