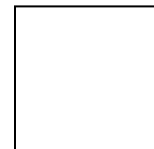

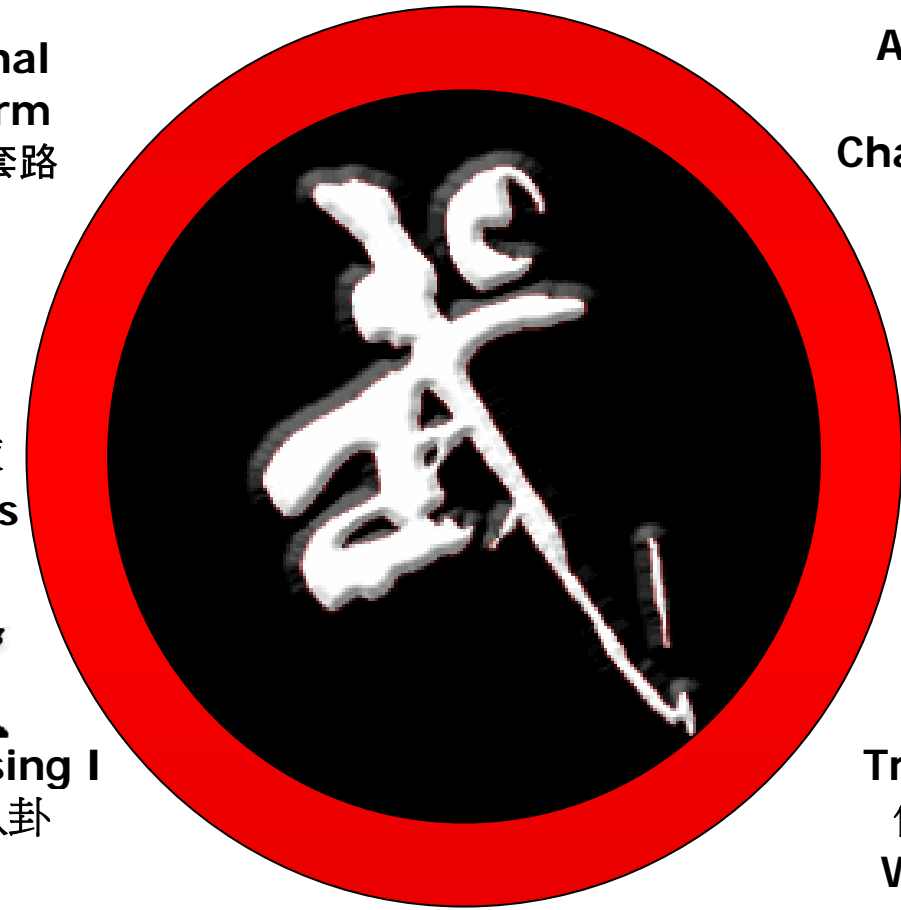

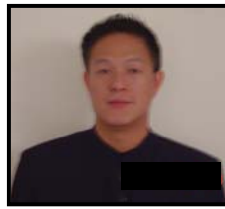

ALL-AROUND GRAND CHAMPIONSHIPS

NOTE: The competition categories below will be for the title of *All-Around Forms Champions in both Traditional and Modern Wushu.*

Traditional

- 1) Hand Form
- 2) Short Weapon
- 3) Long Weapon
- 4) Other Weapons

Modern-Wushu

- 1) Long Fist
- 2) Short Weapon
(Straight/Broad sword)
- 3) Long Weapon
(Spear/Staff)

COMPETITION TIER

(traditional Kung Fu will be competing separately from Modern Wushu)

- *12 & under
- *13-17 years of age
- *18 & up

SCORING AND WINNING

All scores will be combined and totaled in the three divisions. High and low scores will be discarded. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places will receive a medal.

IN THE EVENT OF A TIE...

Competitors will compete in one more hand-form other than what has already been used for the competition.

Fighting Sets	50 sec- 1min. 30sec max
Tai Ji	4-5 min. max
Tai Ji Weapons	3-4 min. max
Group Forms	50 sec- 4min. max (music allowed)

SKILL LEVELS

Beginners	under 2 years of experience
Intermediate	2-4 years of experience
Advanced	over 4 years of experience
International	over 8 years of experience

(Modern Wushu Competition will be on an approximately 14m x 8m field)
