### Tournament Rules:

#### Rules for Tournament Participants:

All USATT Regulations Apply

**General dress code:** All USATT rules will be enforced, Players must wear dark clothing and Clothing must **NOT be solid orange** in color, their rackets must be covered with rubber. Bare wood, sandpaper, or plastic rackets are not allowed. Shoes must be non-marking rubber-soled shoes on wood floors.

\***AGE Event:** Personal Identification Card is required during check-in, e. g driver license or student ID.

### FORMAT:

- \* **All Events are Single elimination: Matches are Best-of -Five.**  
**Open Singles semi- final /finals** and the **finals of all singles events**, which is **Best -of- Seven**
- **All events: Single elimination.** If the singles or doubles event has less than four players/teams, round robin will apply. Events may be canceled or combined if there are insufficient entries and fees will be refunded.
- Player's assignment based on the lottery drawing before the games.
- **Each player must have a registration form for single. Each double/team needs only one team form.**
- **Players should check in to the desk 30 minutes before each game. Game is forfeited for any late check-in. No refunds will be given for forfeited games.**
- **Each player is limited to four events** (2 Single events+1Double + 1 Team)or

- (3 Single events+1Double or 1 Team) Each player can only belong to one “Institutional group”.
- In the registration form, the “Institutional Group” is for calculation of overall group score.
- Please write clearly and correctly to avoid unnecessary mistakes.



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- Please provide your e-mail address and phone number so that we can inform you of events.
- Ten minutes is given before the player forfeits his/her game.
- **Gluing:** All gluing **must be done outside of gym**; a table will be provided.
- **Absolutely NO FOOD and DRINK in the gym.**
- Food booths will be available
- **\*Team Competition:** Each team should have **minimum of 4 players** and **maximum of 5 players** (include all ages and levels). Each player can only belong to one “Institutional group”.  
(3 single, 2 double)
- **All players on one team should be registered on the same registration form**, two substitute players can be added on to the form but no new players can be swapped after the registration.
- **Please be sure to fill out the team name.**

### Note:

**START TIMES:** Every player must report to the control desk 30 minutes prior to the start of their first event. Each player may only enter one event per start time. This means one can only enter a maximum of 4 Events.

**EVENTS:** Events may be canceled or combined if there are insufficient entries and fees will be refunded.

**AGE EVENTS:** The eligibility of a participant for age events is determined by the participant’s age on June 20th, 2009 (day of event). Age event participants must bring ID.

**RATINGS:** Ratings used for entry will be the ones in the April/May issue of USATT magazine. Ratings used for seeding will be from the most recent rating list received.\* Last Year every event’s champions will be seeding before rating seeding.

Open Team, (\$150, 1<sup>st</sup>), (\$75, 2<sup>nd</sup>), (\$50, 3<sup>rd</sup>), junior open Team under 18, (\$50, 1<sup>st</sup>), (\$30, 2<sup>nd</sup>)

\* **Beg/Intermediate** registrants must conform to one of the below.

1. Individuals with USATT Rating of 1500 or under.
2. For the Under 2800 Doubles event, the highest rated player in a doubles team must be under 1600.  
For the Under 3600 Doubles event, the highest rated player in a doubles team must be under 2100
3. Players with no rating, Players new to this tournament, or has never won any gold medal.

**\*\*This schedule is preliminary but based on Team competition to start first. The final schedule will be published on the web one week before the tournament. Phone inquire will be available as well.**

**Note:**

- 1 The players who are not qualified as beginner will be placed into advanced level.
- 2 Players under 8 years old can play either under 8 years and over
- 3 Players above 70 years old can play either 70 and under.
- 4 Groups may be combined if insufficient players are registered.
- 5 Based on single elimination but may use round robin, if appropriate.
- \*\* 6 Awards Prize: Cash prize for Open Single and Team  
Awards: Trophy or Medal,  
Awards Gift: Gift certificate, Gift  
Souvenir: Each Player will have one pack of gift.

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
